21 MEMBER FAIRS: Attica Independent (Seneca County), Berea (Cuyahoga County), Bowling Green (Wood County), Burton (Geauga County), Croton (Hartford Independent), Delaware (Delaware County), Hicksville (Defiance County), Marion (Marion County), Marysville (Union County), Montpelier (Williams County), Mt. Gilead (Morrow County), Napoleon (Henry County), Northfield (Summit County), Oak Harbor (Ottawa County), Painesville (Lake County), Paulding (Paulding County), Richwood Independent (Union County), Tiffin (Seneca County), Upper Sandusky (Wyandot County), Van Wert (Van Wert County), Wauseon (Fulton County).

- Eligibility to only those foals sired by a Standardbred stallion registered with the Ohio State Racing Commission during the year of conception. Horses must be registered with the United States Trotting Association before nomination.
- Nomination fee across the board for 2- and 3-year-old Ohio Sired horses \$420 across-the-board for the 21 OFRC Fairs. There will be two levels (Scarlet and Gray) of entry fees at the fairs. Entry fee due at time of declaration \$100 for Scarlet fairs and \$200 for Gray fairs.
- Details of each level are as follows:
 - Scarlet – The Fair's contribution to the stakes race will be \$ 500.
 - Gray – The Fair's contribution to the stakes race will be \$1,000.
- All nominations and entry fees will be added to the purse by age, gait & division. All payments are forfeited. Nomination and entry fees are non-refundable.
- Please give the names of the Fairs at which the horses are to be nominated at \$75 per fair, if they are not nominated at the across-the-board rate of \$420 per horse. Any horse entered by a Nominator who pays fees with a dishonored check may be dropped from the eligibility list and referred to the O.S.R.C. under Ohio Administrative rule 3769-7-42.
- Membership All owners of each entered colt or filly must be a Full Active member of the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association (OHHA) for \$65 per owner, due with nomination, if not already paid. Each membership receives a card good for one admission to Ohio Fair Racing Conference member fairs on race days. Associate Membership Additional passes to OFRC member fairs on race day may be obtained by becoming Associate Member of the OHHA for \$25 per member. Fair Boards will be considered members of the Ohio Fair Racing Conference if they have joined the OHHA as an Associate Member.
- A horse nominated at one gait may move to the other gait by advising the OHHA. If any colt or filly changes gait after nomination, it may be transferred to the adopted gait at the time of entry. If possible, all payments will follow the entry, due to change of gait.
- All races will be one-mile dashes. Three Day Box (Except Northfield – Summit County Fair). In all divided races, the entry fee shall follow the horse.
- Splits at Host Fair will be as follows:
 - 4 wide – split at 7
 - 5 wide – split at 8
 - 6 wide – split at 9
 - 7 wide – split at 10
 - 8 wide – split at 11
- The purse for each race will be divided as follows:
 - 5 or more to start 50-25-12-8-5 %
 - 4 to start 55-25-12-8%
 - 3 starters 55-30-15%
 - 2 starters 65-35%
 - 1 starter 100% and horse must start and go over the course.
- Trophies awarded at the Annual Awards Banquet will be based on the system of points as follows: Win-51, Second-26, Third-13, Fourth-9, Fifth-6 and all remaining starters-1. In the event of a dead-heat, as with purse money division, horses shall receive the standard distribution of points for their particular-order of finish.
- Points shall be awarded according to any placing of the judges. Any pending appeal of a ruling issued by the judges shall not alter the placing determined by the judges. Participants with appeals yet to be decided at the time of declaration for the Ohio Fairs Championship will have points deducted for the violation. In the case of a positive drug test, all appeals will have points deducted for a placing, unless the case has a final, unappealable decision prior to declaration for the Ohio Fairs Championship.
- Should any participant in the Ohio Fair Racing Conference be notified of a positive drug test result in any Ohio Fair Racing Conference Race, he/she must notify the Ohio Harness Horseman's Association upon receipt of the notice.
- Cancellations. If circumstances prevent racing any leg at the scheduled racetrack on its advertised date, the OHHA may reschedule it on another date or at another track.
- Unless otherwise specifically stated in the Ohio Fair Racing Conference conditions, Ohio State Racing Commission Rules will govern. The interpretation of any of the conditions and settlement of any disputes that arise will be determined by the OHHA in their sole and complete discretion in making a final decision. The OHHA reserves the sole and exclusive right to modify, alter, amend and/or cancel this event in its entirety.

The 15 Members Fairs For The Home Talent Circuit Are: Trumbull (Cortland); Franklin (Hilliard); Carroll (Carrollton); Crawford (Bucyrus); Knox (Mt. Vernon); Richland (Mansfield); Columbiana (Lisbon); Lorain (Wellington); Jefferson (Ashtabula); Stark (Canton); Mahoning (Canfield); Wayne (Wooster); Ashland (Ashland); Dover (Tuscarawas) and Coshocton (Coshocton).



ONE TIME PAYMENT – NO SUSTAINING FEES

Horsemen will make a one-time payment of \$500.00 Per horse and be able to enter whatever fairs you desire at time of declaration. There will be no other payment before starting your horse.

- If you wish to enter only one (1) and no more than three (3) fairs you may do so by paying \$100.00 per fair and then \$100.00 starting fee at time of entry. **You must name these fairs at this time and this cannot be changed.**

- Starting fee will be \$100.00 per horse. This must be paid if you enter the horse and then do not declare it to start.

- All entry fees will be divided equally between the (15) member fairs at gait and sex. Starting fees and individual fair nominations will be added at each fair respectfully.

- Payment can be made by check or credit card (Credit cards will be charged a 3.5% convenience fee on total amount charged)

NOMINATE Across the Board in the HTCS and you can nominate up to 3 additional fairs in the SVCC or OCRA for a \$30 service fee per fair (this will not be added to the purses and there is no membership fee to that circuit). \$5 from each bonus fee collected will be used for a 2020 BFRC scholarship. Information about the scholarship can be found at hometalentcoltstakes.com. Send all forms and payments (made out to the individual circuits) along with your HTCS Across the Board nomination form and I will see that the nomination(s) is recorded with the proper circuit. Please use their forms located in this booklet. This is SVCC, HTCS and OCRA circuits working together for you. And remember this is only available to those who nominate ACROSS THE BOARD. Nominations booklets will be mailed only to those requesting them. Nominations can be found on our website at www.hometalentcoltstakes.com. If you have access to a computer, please get your nomination on the website.

MEMBERSHIP \$50.00 Per owner. Each member will receive BFRC passes paid at nomination time.

ELIGIBILITY (1) All foals must be sired by a stallion registered with the state racing commission

(2) Eligible stallions, which means those stallions: (A) Owned by a resident of Ohio and regularly standing the entire stud season in Ohio; or (B) Owned by a resident of a state other than Ohio but regularly standing the entire stud season in Ohio and leased by a resident of Ohio for term of not less than ten years; or (C) Owned jointly by a resident of a state other than Ohio and a resident of Ohio, regularly standing the entire stud season in Ohio, and leased by a resident of Ohio for a term of not less than ten years.

- Each race shall be conditioned to admit only registered two-year-old and three-year-old colts and fillies sired by a registered stallion owned or leased and permanently standing for service at and within this state at the time of foal's conception, at each gait of trotting and pacing.

- Change of Gait- If any horse changes gait it may be transferred to the adopted gait until time of declaration to start.

HOME TALENT RACING CONDITIONS All fairs have a 3-day box- Exception Hilliard & Canfield. Check Huff's Guide

All races conducted according to the rules of the O.S.R.C and the U.S.T.A. ALL FAIRS WILL RACE ALL STAKES ONE HEAT ONLY: in the event more than 8 colts or fillies (6 at Lisbon, 7 at Wooster and Jefferson) are declared in to start, the race shall be split and raced in division each division will race for an equal share of the total purse, with exception of the declaration fee which will follow the colt or filly.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION 50%-25%-12%-8%-5%, 4 to start: 55%-25%-12%-8%, 3 to start: 60%-28%-12%, 2 to start: 65%-35%, 1 to start 100%

Driver Insurance will be at all fairs, courtesy of OHHA & The Home Talent Colt Stakes Association.

2021 Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium Bonus Plan

With your ACROSS the BOARD entry at any of the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium circuits, you may select up to 3 additional fairs for that horse in any other member circuit at a cost of a \$30 service fee per fair (service fee to the circuit which you are nominating will not be used for purse money and there will not be a membership charged for that circuit. **Entries which are not ACROSS THE BOARD will not get the bonus plan.** Each circuit has a fee per horse/per fair for individual fair selections with a mandatory membership fee.

2. Memberships of \$50 each are required for each registered owner of each horse. Memberships are per person and not per horse (an owner may have several horses but only needs to pay the membership fee once). Passes will be universal to all circuits in the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium (OCRA, SVCC & Home Talent Colt Stakes) and will be mailed by early June.
3. AS A BONUS: Nominate across the board in HTCS and select up to 3 fairs for that horse from the Southern Valley or OCRA circuits for \$30 per fair which will be sent by the HTCS to the appropriate circuit. \$5 of every bonus payment will go to the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium Scholarship which will be given in summer 2021.
4. Reproduce and use this form as many times as needed to include all your horses. You may add up on the final page.
5. Starting fees are \$100 payable to the fair to which the horse has been declared, even if the horse is scratched.
6. As a courtesy, horses may be nominated to the Delaware County Fair Stakes on this form as a single fair for \$75. Delaware is not included in the ATB option for HTCS and is not a member fair of the HTCS. Delaware nominations will be sent to OHHA from the HTCS. OFRC rules apply.

ELIGIBILITY for two (2) and three (3) year olds in 2021 and must be sired by a stallion registered with the Ohio State Racing Commission.

ONE TIME PAYMENT NO SUSTAINING PAYMENT MARCH 15, 2021

- One-time payment \$500 per horse, to be eligible to race at all 19 fairs.
- Individual fairs may be chosen by paying a one-time payment of \$75 per horse per fair. Indicate which fairs.
- **AS A BONUS:** Nominate across the board in OCRA and select up to 3 fairs for that horse from the Southern Valley or Home Talent circuits for \$30 per fair which will be sent by the OCRA to the appropriate circuit. \$5 of each bonus fair fee will go to the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium Scholarship which will be given in summer 2021.
- **Dr. H.M. Parshall Memorial Stakes #69 Late Supplemental Fee** – for any OCRA eligible 2YO that nominates across the board in the OCRA (the sponsor of the Parshall Memorial Stakes). Select the Parshall (2YO Only) box on the nomination form and pay the additional \$100 fee to make the horse eligible for the Dr. H.M. Parshall Memorial Stakes #69 to be raced (both the trot and the pace) at the Great Darke County Fair, Greenville, Ohio on Thursday August 26, 2021. Estimated purses of \$40,000 for Parshall Stakes #69 (est. \$23,000 pace & \$17,000 trot based on projections as of 01/01/2021). This fee also makes the horse eligible as a 3YO should they not start at age 2.

MEMBERSHIP All registered owners at time of submission of each colt or filly must be a member of the O.C.R.A. to make a nomination. Memberships are per person and not per horse (an owner may have several horses but only needs to pay the membership fee once). The \$35.00 fee is due and payable for each registered owner of the horse when making the nomination payment by **MARCH 15, 2021**

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP For non-owners such as grooms, family members or friends of racing will be \$20.00 each.

FAIR PASSES One membership card will be mailed in May for each membership and associate membership which has been paid. Cards will admit one person to the fairs on race day. This will be a universal pass for all circuits in the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium (43 fairs). Please specify if the passes should be mailed to the membership holder or to the person making the nomination.

DECLARATIONS close at 10:00 A.M. **THREE (3) DAYS** before the race, unless listed differently under a fair's conditions in the Huff's Guide.

STARTING FEE \$100.00 payment is due and payable the day of race, even if the horse is scratched. In the event more than 8 horses are declared in to start, the race shall be divided and raced in divisions with no more than 2 trailers. Each division will race for an equal share of the total purse. The Judge may alter the division of the race in any way, taking into consideration track safety. OSRC/USTA Rules to govern all races.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION The purse for each race will be divided as follows:
5 or more to start: 50%-25%-12%-8%-5% 4 to start: 55%-25%-12%-8% 3 to start: 60%-28%-12% 2 to start: 65%-35% 1 to start 100% and the horse must start and go over the course.

TROPHIES will be awarded at the annual banquet to owners of colts and fillies winning the most points in each class based on the following system: Win-51, Second-26, Third-13, Fourth-9, Fifth-6 and all remaining starters-1. In the event of a dead-heat, as with purse money division, horses shall receive the standard distribution of points for their particular order of finish. Any pending appeal of a placing ruling issued by the judges shall not alter the point standing. OCRA driver and trainer awards will be based on the most wins in the circuit for the year.

CONDITIONS FOR COLT & FILLY EARLY CLOSERS

- ✓ All foals must be sired by a stallion registered with the Ohio State Racing Commission.
- ✓ Nomination Fee - \$450 to be paid on or before **March 15th** on each colt or filly which makes the entrant eligible for all 10 fairs or \$60 per fair to be paid on or before **March 15th**.
- ✓ No Sustaining Fees.
- ✓ Starting Fee - \$75 due and payable at time of declaration.
- ✓ Nominating and Starting Fees shall be added to the base purse.
- ✓ Each and Every owner of every entered colt or filly must be a member of the Southern Valley Colt Circuit and pay annual membership dues of \$35. Please include each owner's Social Security Number. This list will be provided to member fairs, if requested, to help expedite the distribution of purse checks immediately following the races. **This is due and must be paid at the time of nomination - March 15, 2021.**
- ✓ All fairs will have a two (2) day box closing at 11:00 AM. Check "Huff's Guide" for verification.
- ✓ Change of gait permissible up to declaration time; transfer to adopted gait allowed.
- ✓ All races are mile dashes. Single heats for 2 and 3 year olds - 100% of total purse.
- ✓ In the event there are more horses declared to start than the track will permit, the race will be divided and raced in divisions, each division will race for an equal share of the total purse.
- ✓ Should the race be split into divisions, there will be no more than two (2) horses in the second tier. **Rock Springs will score 4 wide, Zanesville will score 6 wide and the remaining fairs will score 5 wide.**
- ✓ Colts will race with colts and fillies will race with fillies unless the Department of Agriculture rules differently.
- ✓ Alcoholic beverages and the use of profane and/or abusive language are not permitted in or around the barn and race track area.
- ✓ Accident insurance will be provided by the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association.
- ✓ **NOMINATE Across The Board in the Southern Valley Colt Circuit and you can nominate up to 3 additional fairs in the Home Talent or OCRA for a \$30 service fee per fair (this will not be added to the purses, there is no membership fee to that circuit and \$5 will be for a scholarship program). Send all forms and payments (made out to the individual circuits) along with your SVCC Across The Board nomination form and I will see the nomination(s) is recorded with the proper circuit. This is the Southern Valley, Home Talent and OCRA circuits working together for you and remember this is only available to those who nominate ACROSS THE BOARD.**

- ✓ For any fair that cancels live horse racing prior to any live race day draw; the across the board nomination money will be apportioned by Division equally to the fairs that will conduct live racing in that Circuit from the cancelled fair's date forward, the single fair nomination money will be refunded to the nominator of the horse. If a cancellation occurs at a point in the Circuit's Fair Racing Season that makes it impractical or impossible to roll the nomination fees forward, then any remaining nomination monies will be refunded to the nominator of the horse nominated to that Circuit. All refunds will occur at the conclusion of the Fair racing season.
